Rules and obligations for Erasmus incomers

Arrival procedures

Registration procedures will start at Welcome Days.

Akademia Wychowania Fizycznego we Wroclawiu organizes 3-4 Welcome Days, for each semester, whose dates are indicated on this website.

Welcome days attendance is obligatory!

Students must come with:

- A current passport or ID copy which will remain valid until after the end of study exchange period
- European Health Insurance Card, which entitles you to free health care services in Poland

The First Day date will be indicated as arrival date on Recognition certificate.

Departure procedures

At the end of mobility, students must visit AWF Erasmus Office with:

- student card
- learning agreement
- evaluation card
- lessons attendance
- university dorm proof of payment

The end of semester will be indicated as departure date on Recognition certificate. There is not possibility to finish Erasmus mobility before the end of semester!

Learning agreement

Document can include only the courses and related ECTS credits <u>offered to international students at AWF</u> <u>Wroclaw</u>. The maximum ECTS credits for one semester is 30. The minimum ECTS credits to be accepted in AWF Wroclaw is 20.

Student can change Learning Agreement ones for each semester. Changes to LA should be done within the first two weeks of stay.

To change LA student has to fill in part DURRING MOBILITY (remember to sign it!) and bring the document to the International Office. The Erasmus coordinator is responsible to stamp it and forward to student Home University.

Classes attendance

Participation in classes is mandatory and students' attendance is checked at each by teachers. Student is therefore obliged to attend all classes that he/she has declared in the Learning Agreement. In case of more than 3 unjustified absences at a class student will not be allowed to take the exam and will not be awarded credits for the course.

Language Skills

As all classes are held in English, Erasmus incoming students will be required to achieve at least Level B2.

Student application/stay will be accepted only if student can prove knowledge of English with one of the following documents:

- FCE First Certificate in English
- CAE Certificate in Advanced English
- **CPE** Certificate of Proficiency in English
- BEC Business English Certificate
- **TOEFL** Test of English as a Foreign Language
- LCCI London Chamber of Commerce and Industry Examination Board
- ESOL English for Speakers of Other Languages
- IELTS International English Language Testing System
- or
- Language certificate of your home University.

Please note that if your language level is not satisfactory during the classes, student will be tested by our language examiners. Failing the test will terminate stay at our university.
