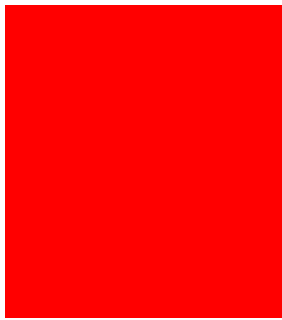

<b>Scholarship</b>	⇒	Swiss Government Excellence Postdoctoral Scholarships for foreign researchers
<b>Offered by</b>	⇒	The Swiss Government through the Federal Commission for Scholarships for Foreign Students FCS
<b>Objectives</b>	⇒	To enable selected applicants to undertake a postdoctoral research in one of the 10 Swiss Public Universities, the two Swiss Federal Institutes of Technology, the public teaching and research institutes and the Universities of Applied Sciences.

<b>Validity</b>	⇒	The Scholarship is only valid for a full time postdoctoral research in Switzerland. It is not valid for mixed postdoctoral research (part time in Switzerland and part time in a third country).
<b>Target Group</b>	⇒	Highly qualified postdoctoral researchers from all academic fields.

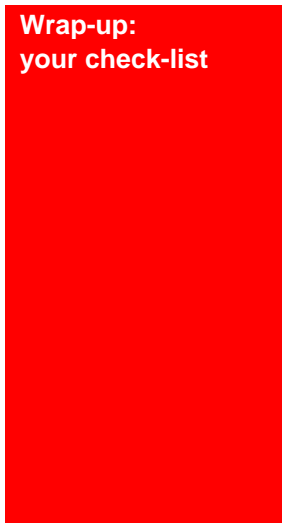
<b>Duration</b>	⇒ 12 months
<b>Amount and additional allowances</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ The scholarship amounts to a monthly payment of 3'500 Swiss Francs.</li> <li>⇒ Exemption of the tuition fees (except for EPFL).</li> <li>⇒ Mandatory Swiss Health insurance paid by the FCS (for non-EU and EFTA grantees only).</li> <li>⇒ A lump sum for air fare for non-European grantees only (provided at the end of the scholarship).</li> <li>⇒ Special 300 Swiss Francs housing allowance (paid once at the beginning of the scholarship).</li> <li>⇒ 1 year half-fare public transportation card.</li> <li>⇒ Counseling and various trips, dinners and sight-seeing tours organized for Swiss Government Excellence Scholarship holders.</li> </ul>
<b>Eligibility Criteria and specific conditions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ PhD degree</li> <li>⇒ There cannot be a gap of more than 5 years between the award of the PhD and the application deadline.</li> <li>⇒ Applicants who are in Switzerland for more than 1 year at the beginning of the scholarship are not eligible.</li> <li>⇒ Applicants must provide a letter (e-mail) from a Professor from the Swiss host institution stating that he/she is willing to supervise the postdoctoral research. Without such a document the application will be rejected.</li> <li>⇒ Applicants must have a research proposal including a timeframe (this is the central piece of the application. The applicant must devote all required attention to it).</li> <li>⇒ Applicants must be in command of the necessary language skills required for the postdoctoral research.</li> <li>⇒ Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Excellence Scholarship are not eligible to apply for a second scholarship.</li> </ul>
<b>Selection Criteria</b>	<p>The following dimensions and selection criteria are considered mainly:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ The candidate: Her/his academic profile and research capacity.</li> <li>⇒ The research project: It's originality and methodological soundness.</li> <li>⇒ The academic context: The quality of supervision and the potential for future academic cooperation.</li> </ul>
<b>Application Procedure</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ The application package can be obtained by e-mail from the Swiss Embassy in Tbilisi.</li> <li>⇒ The deadline for the submission of applications is 28.11.2014</li> <li>⇒ Applications have to be submitted in 3 copies (hard copies only).</li> </ul>
<b>Application Time Framework</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Opening of the call: 01.09.2014</li> <li>⇒ Application Deadline: 28.11.2014</li> <li>⇒ Selection Interview, ask: Swiss Embassy</li> <li>⇒ Beginning of the scholarship: 14.09.2015</li> </ul>
<b>Application documents</b> (Please provide 3 sets of copies on <u>A4 paper</u> . Please do not staple the documents and/or put them into plastic sheets or binders).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ The FCS 2015-2016 official application form (typed and printed). <u>No handwritten forms will be accepted.</u></li> <li>⇒ Copies of all university certificates and grade-sheets (all copies must be attested, and translated if originals are not in English, German, French or Italian. Attestations can be done by the University or a Government Officer.</li> <li>⇒ 2 letters of recommendation from Professors in the applicants field (<u>use exclusively</u> the official reference form provided with the application package).</li> </ul>



- ⇒ A complete research proposal (max. 5 pages), use exclusively the official research proposal form provided with the application package.
- ⇒ A motivation letter (max. 2 pages).
- ⇒ A full curriculum vitae with list of academic publications.
- ⇒ A copy of the confirmation from a Professor at the intended Swiss University that he/she is willing to supervise the Postdoctoral Research.
- ⇒ A health certificate (use exclusively the official health certificate provided with the application package).
- ⇒ A copy of the passport (main page with personal data).
