



The Estonian Ministry of Foreign Affairs is funding a Scholarship Program within the Development Cooperation Scheme of the Republic of Estonia towards its priority partner state Georgia, for supporting the Georgian university graduates in the acquisition of higher education and conducting of research in Estonia.

Five Scholarships are awarded for full-time studies (2 years) at the Master's Programme in *Human-Computer Interaction (HCI)* at Tallinn University, Estonia.

The Scholarship is covering the following costs for 2 academic years:

- A tuition fee of 1100 Euros per semester (4 semesters).
- A monthly allowance of 400 Euros, for 10 months (from September to June) in each year.

Who is eligible to apply?

The Scholarship Program is available to Georgian citizens, as prospective graduates of 2015 from the following Georgian state universities:

- Step 1: Apply online at https://estonia.dreamapply.com/en_GE/courses/course/51
- Step 2: Send the additional documents by mail
- *Step 3:* Submit your digital portfolio and a motivation letter

Step 4: Take an admission interview on May 5, 2015 via Skype. Applicants wishing to recieve the Scholarship should indicate their need in the motivation letter.

Application Deadline: May 1, 2015.

Applicants will be notified of the decisions regarding admission and scholarship allocation via e-mail, by May 15, 2015.
