# UNESCO/PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA - THE GREAT WALL CO-SPONSORED FELLOWSHIPS PROGRAMME 2015-2016

With a view to promoting international exchanges in the field of education, culture, communication, science and technology, and to enhancing friendship among peoples of the world, the Government of the People's Republic of China has placed at the disposal of UNESCO for the academic year 2015-2016, under the co-sponsorship of UNESCO, **seventy-five (75)** fellowships for advanced studies at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. These fellowships are for the benefit of developing Member States in Africa, Asia–Pacific, Latin America, Europe and Arab region (see Annex I).

The fellowships, tenable at a selected number of Chinese universities, are for a duration of one year. These fellowships, which are in most cases to be conducted in English, are offered to senior advanced students wishing to pursue higher studies or intending to undertake individual research with periodic guidance from the assigned supervisor. In exceptional cases, candidates may be required to study Chinese language before taking up research/study in their fields of interest.

### A. FIELDS OF PROPOSED STUDIES AT SELECTED UNIVERSITIES

### B. QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

- (i) Hold at least the equivalent of the Master's Degree/above or the Bachelor's Degree;
- (ii) English proficiency is required;
- (iii) Be not more than 45 years of age; and
- (iv) Be in good health, both physically and mentally.

### C. PROCEDURE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

All applications should be endorsed by the relevant Government body (the National Commission or Permanent Delegation) and must be prepared in English with the following attachments (see Annex III):

- (i) Application form for China/UNESCO The Great Wall Fellowship in triplicate; Complete the online application procedure at CSC Online Application System for International Students (http://www.csc.edu.cn/laihua/noticeen.html, submit online the completed Application Form and print hard copies;
- (ii) 3 photographs;
- (iii) Notarized photocopies of diplomas and certificates, and school-certified transcripts of complete academic records (translated in English when applicable), in triplicate;
- (iv) Pre-admission Letter from designated Chinese university (if available): in triplicate:
- Two letters of recommendation (in English) by professors or associate professors familiar with the work of the candidate, in triplicate;
- (vi) A study or research proposal containing no less than 400 words (in English) of the post-graduate study to be undertaken during the candidate's stay in China, in triplicate;
- (vii) Foreigner Physical Examination form to be completed and communicated to UNESCO by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2015 (copy attached), in triplicate; and
- (viii) English language proficiency certificate, in triplicate.

\*When completing the form, each candidate is requested to specify 3 possible host institutions in China indicating one field of study as personal preference. Applicants may wish to visit the web page of China Scholarship Council (<a href="http://en.csc.edu.cn/">http://en.csc.edu.cn/</a>); sellect the "Study in China" tab on the above menu; and refer to the "Chinese Higher Education Institutions Admitting International Students under CGSP" hyperlink listed for details on the selected host institutions. ### D. SUBMISSION OF CANDIDATURES

The letter of nomination should reach UNESCO (Attention: Stoyan Bantchev, Chief of the Participation Programme and Fellowships Section) 7 Place de Fontenoy, 75352 Paris 07 SP, France, imperatively by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2015 at the latest. An advance copy of the application can be sent by email (I.ndobo@unesco.org; i.genevois@unesco.org and v.lopy@unesco.org).

Files which are not complete or which are received after the above deadline, as well as candidates who do not fulfill the above-mentioned requirements, will not be taken into consideration.

### E. SELECTION OF BENEFICIARIES

The Chinese authorities will select the **seventy-five (75)** most qualified candidates. The National Commissions of the **selected** fellows will be duly informed by UNESCO.

Candidates not informed of their selection by 31 July 2015 should consider that their applications have not been approved

# F. FACILITIES OFFERED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

- (i) One round trip international travel to and from China (for the first 50 fellows);
- (ii) A monthly living allowance of CNY 3,000 Yuan for general scholars or CNY 3,500 Yuan for senior scholars will be granted covering meals and pocket expenses;
- (iii) tuition waver.
- (iv) Accommodation: free university dormitory or accommodation subsidy; If the host university requires students to live on campus, the university will accommodate scholarship students in university dormitory (usually twin room); if the host university permits students to live off campus, the university will provide monthly / quarterly accommodation subsidy: undergraduate students / master's students / general scholars: CNY 700 per month; doctoral students / senior scholars: CNY 1000 per month.
- (v) Comprehensive Medical Insurance\*\* and Protection Scheme for International Students in China

### G. FACILITIES OFFERED BY UNESCO

- (i) One round trip international travel to and from China (for 25 fellows);
- (ii) a one-time initial allowance of USD150 and a termination allowance of USD200 to cover excess lugage charges at time of fellows' return to their home

<sup>\*\*</sup>The students are to cover a certain percentage of expenses. Claim for compensation with the relevant payment receipts may be asked from the insurance company according to the stipulated insurance articles. The individual claim will not be accepted by the insurance company.

Country, in addition to the living allowance granted by the Government of the People's Republic of China.

Important: No allowance to finance or lodge married couples or family members will be granted.

(Note: It is the National authorities' responsibility to ensure that all candidates are duly informed of all the above-mentioned conditions before the submission of applications for the fellowships.)

## Chinese Government Scholarship-Great Wall Program

Chinese Government Scholarship - Great Wall Program is a full scholarship established by MOE for the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to sponsor students and scholars in developing countries to study and conduct research in China.

Supporting Categories, Duration and Language of Instruction

This program only supports, in general, one-year English-taught programs for general scholars and senior scholars. Scholarship recipients of Chinese-taught programs without adequate Chinese proficiency are required to get the approval from both CSC and

UNESCO for one-year Chinese language study.

Where to Apply and Deadline

You should apply through the National Commission for UNESCO in your home country between May and early June.

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must:

- be a citizen of a developing country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health;
- be under the age of 45 and have completed at least two years of undergraduate study when applying for general scholar programs;
- be a master's degree holder or an associate professor (or above) under the age of 50 when applying for senior scholar programs.

### **Application Procedure**

1. Apply through the National Commission for UNESCO in your home country for CGS opportunity.

It is your own responsibility to consult the National Commission for UNESCO in your country for the requirements and make sure you are eligible for the scholarship.

2. Apply to your target university for Pre-admission Letter once recommended by the dispatching authorities as an eligible candidate (you will receive an Award Letter for CGS Candidate).

- 3. Complete the online application procedure at <u>CSC Online Application System for International Students</u> (http://www.csc.edu.cn/laihua/noticeen.html, submit online the completed Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship and print a hard copy.
- 4. Submit all your application documents to the National Commission for UNESCO in your home country before the deadline.

You can check Application Documents for a detailed checklist.

5. Only applications of recommended candidates from UNESCO will be considered. No other applications or individual application directly sent to CSC will be considered. Candidates holding Pre-admission Letter will be placed in the host university; those without Pre-admission Letter should accept CSC's placement of university.

#### NOTE

You should consult the National Commission for UNESCO in your home country for Instructions of CSC Online Application System for International Students and Agency Number.

**Application Documents (in duplicate)** 

1. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship (written in Chinese or English;

Ensure you have both submitted it online and printed the hard copy.

2. Notarized highest diploma (photocopy);

Prospective diploma winners must submit official document issued by your current school to prove your current student status or expected graduation date.

Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

3. Academic transcripts (written in Chinese or English);

Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

4. Two Recommendation Letters (written in Chinese or English);

Applicants for senior scholar programs must submit two recommendation letters signed by professor or associate professor.

5. A CD of your own works (only required for arts students);

Applicants for music studies are requested to submit a CD of their own musical works. Applicants for fine arts programs must submit a CD of their own works which include two sketches, two color paintings and two other works.

6. A Study Plan or Research Proposal (written in Chinese or English);

This should be a minimum of 500 words.

7. Foreigner Physical Examination Form (photocopy) (written in English, only required for applicants planning to stay in China for more than 6 months);

The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete forms or forms without the signature of the attending physician, or the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicant are considered as invalid.

Please carefully plan your physical examination schedule as the result is valid for only 6 months.

Pleases keep the original copy of the Form for school registration.

- 8. Pre-admission Letter from designated Chinese university (if available);
- 9. Valid HSK Certificate (if available).

### NOTE

All the documents should be bound together on top left corner in the order of 6.1 to 6.9.

You should submit TWO sets of bound documents.

Application documents should be sent to UNESCO by the National Commission for UNESCO before June 1st.

No application documents will be returned.

Placement & Scholarship Confirmation

1. Application documents of recommended candidates from UNESCO will be considered by CSC for eligibility and qualification.

Ineligible or incomplete applications will not be considered.

2. Qualified applications will be sent to universities for placement. Candidates who are turned down by universities will not be granted with the scholarship.

CSC reserves the right to make necessary adjustments/changes to candidate's host university, field of study, supporting categories and duration of scholarship.

Applications enclosed with Pre-admission Letter will be sent to the universities who issued that Letter for placement confirmation.

3. CSC reviews the placement results, approves the List of Scholarship Winners and sends the admission documents to the permanent delegation of P. R. China to UNESCO before July 06.

Each scholarship winner will be granted with no more than one scholarship.

- 4. The permanent delegation of P. R. China to UNESCO will send the admission documents (Admission Letter and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201)) to the scholarship winners.
- 5. Scholarship winners shall not change their host university, field of study, or duration of study unless they give up the grant.
- 6. Scholarship will not be reserved if scholarship winner cannot register before the registration deadline.
