



Evaluation Criteria

Several criteria are taken into account for the admission of international applicants to our undergraduate program.

Paper Evaluation

Completed applications are evaluated upon submitted documents: academic report, personal statement, study plan, recommendation letters, and other items.

Language Proficiency / Interview (Optional)

Those who have not submitted the official language proficiency score or do not meet the minimum requirements (TOPIK level 3 or TOEFL 80) must have a language interview. This interview serves to evaluate the applicant's level of language proficiency.

An additional interview may be required for further review of those who already meet the language requirements.

This personal interview will take place on the same day as the language proficiency test.

Students who have passed our language evaluation and successfully gained admission to HUFS are required to submit their official language scores prior to commencement of their degree programs. Students who fail to submit their official language scores within one year will face restrictions in course registration, starting from their second year of enrollment (maximum 12 credits per semester).

*** Exemptions for English Proficiency**

- Applicants whose native language is English
- Applicants who have completed at least two years of full-time academic study in any official English-speaking country and will be awarded a bachelor's degree within two years. If a student has been residing outside of an English-speaking country for more than 2 years, they are required to submit a TOEFL score.

An applicant with non-Korean nationality and both parents also having non-Korean nationality	Completed primary and secondary schools or will have completed primary and secondary schools before enrollment date for the semester, either in or outside of Korea.

- Overseas Koreans or Koreans with dual citizenship are <u>not</u> considered as international students.
- -Home schooled and cyber schooled students are <u>**not**</u> eligible for admissions to HUFS.

3. Pay the application fee

Pay a non-refundable application fee of KRW 150,000 after completing your online application.

4. Submit required documents

B. Other Documents / Certified Copies

- Personal statement and study plan*
- Certificate of graduation or diploma**

- Official certificate of proficiency in Korean or English

5. Check application status

Once you have submitted all required materials, you can track your application online.

6. Confirm admission

Final results will be made available online. Upon successful admission to HUFS, applicants are required to confirm by submitting the advanced enrollment payment.

IMPORTANT NOTES

General Information

There is no fixed entrance quota for any divisions and departments, with the exception of the College of Education.

Those who have passed equivalency exams for secondary education (e.g. GED in the United States and Canada or the Self-Learning Exam in China) are not eligible to matriculate.

If applicants are accepted by more than two universities, they must choose one.

Completing an application

All information must be correct. Any mistakes made are the responsibility of the applicant. Mistakes may affect university admission, so make sure to check carefully that all information is correct.

Paper applications may be accepted from students in exceptional cases (where it is not possible to apply online). Application forms can be found on our website. (http://international.hufs.ac.kr)

* Application fee for paper application is USD \$200.

Submitting an application

Applicants may apply to no more than two majors. Those applying to two majors must submit **two different personal statements and study plans** for each major. (1st Choice and 2nd Choice)

All documents should be submitted in either Korean or English. Any original documents in other languages should be accompanied by notarized English or Korean translation(s).

The completed application packet must be in a sealed envelope and submitted in person. If applicants send their application packets by registered mail, they must be delivered no later than the application deadline.

If any documents are missing, the application will not be considered.

All application materials and fees will not be returned. Revisions are not allowed after submission.

Application fees must be paid upon submission of the application.

Verification Process

Applicants may be requested to submit additional documents, aside from those required for the purpose of verification of school records.

Applicants are required to provide correct contact information regarding the schools that they have attended. Verification of academic records will be done on the basis of such contact information. If this information is found to be incorrect, the application will be disqualified.

Matriculation may be rescinded under the following conditions:

- An applicant is discovered to have applied through illegal means such as submission of false or forged materials
- Omission of any required documents.

Admitted Students

All certified documents must be received no later than the enrollment date for the semester.

All international students, having gained successful admission to HUFS, are required to submit apostille certificates or consular stamps of all high school and university/college diplomas and transcripts/academic records to the Office of International Student Services, prior to the enrollment date for the semester.

Housing

Accommodation is available in our on/off campus dorms. Rooms for either two students (doubles) or three students (triples) are available. Double rooms will be assigned for international students.

All rooms are air-conditioned and come equipped with the following items:

- Bed, Desk, Closet, Locker, Telephone, Refrigerator
- Free Internet Access (Lan-line / Wifi)
- Separate Toilet / Bathroom

Utility rooms are equipped with automatic laundry machines and ironing boards.

Newly enrolled students will have top priority in dormitory placement for the first semester.

However, from second semester on, students will need to compete with local students in order to maintain their stay at the dorm.

The dorm fee is approximately 1 million to 1.3 million KRW per semester.

International Student Services

The Office of International Student Services (OISS) supports all international students at HUFS by providing advice on immigration, academic resources and career opportunities. OISS also offers various programs which foster interaction between international students and Korean students, and facilitates international students' integration into HUFS campus life.

Academic Advising

To resolve academic concerns and help international students achieve their academic goals, HUFS offers these services to international students:

- Career Development Seminar
- Academic Advising Services in Chinese and English
- Mentoring Program for New International Freshmen

Health Services

The HUFS Health Center is located conveniently on campus to provide affordable and accessible health care services to all students. This center is staffed by practitioners and assistants who can conduct medical consultations in English.

ealth Insurance (mandatory)

oon admission to HUFS, every student is **REQUIRED** to have personal halth insurance.

ithout health insurance, students may face disadvantages. (ie., holarship, immigration services) More information will be provided uring new student orientation.

ost of Living

a reference, international students will need approximately between **RW 8,000,000 and KRW 10,000,000** per year (12 months) to pay for commodation, food, transport, books, clothing, health services, tertainment, etc., but this can vary according to individual circumstances.

room in a shared house, not including food, can cost between KRW 0,000 and KRW 450,000 per month and a rent deposit will be required in ost cases.

e amount of the deposit varies from KRW 3,000,000 to KRW 10,000,000.


Appendix - How to Create an Account
